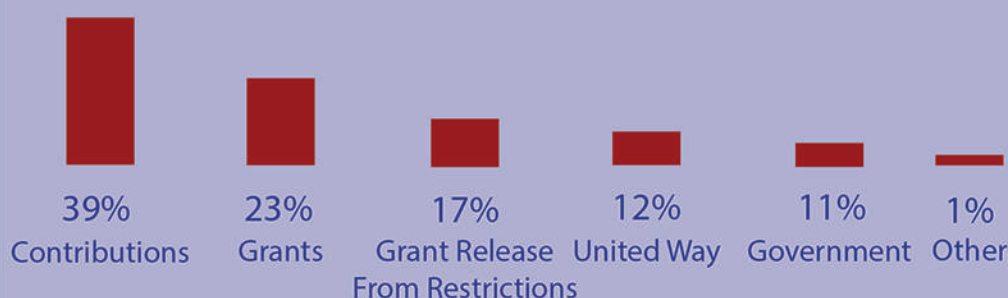
Total revenue including generous donor giving: **\$2,815,315**
